BRIEFING NOTE

Mid-2008 Population Estimates for Settlements and Localities in Stirling

The General Register Office for Scotland (GROS) uses information about postcodes (some 145,000 in Scotland) to define 'settlements' and 'localities' as good approximations to built-up areas.

Localities which make up the settlement of Stirling are provided first, followed by other localities that are not part of a larger settlement.
