It is hoped this initiative will encourage anglers to consider catch and release, it should always be borne in mind "dead salmon don't spawn".

Stirling Council owns the fishing rights for salmon and sea trout on the river Forth between Cambuskenneth and Craigforth and on two separate stretches of the river Teith at Callander.

The Forth and Teith have been described as “hidden gems” with both rivers enjoying excellent runs of salmon and sea trout annually.

Stirling Council’s policy is to offer fishing at a price affordable to all and a whole range of packages are available to cater for all needs.

Both rivers allow fly fishing, spinning and also bait fishing, so from beginner to the most experienced angler there is a real chance to catch the ‘king of fish’.

There are excellent facilities for disabled anglers with platforms erected on the Forth at Craigforth and also on the Teith at the Geisher Pool on the outskirts of Callander.
