The weight of a single bus is 7 tons, double 14 tons, and that is without fuel. The other issue is the fear of these buses, plus all the other traffic is a worry regarding water and gas pipes. After all, they have other routes they can take. For example, Kerse Road, which they have been using up till May this year, or the main road to St Ninians.
